DISCHARGE INSTRUCTIONS

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SURGICAL PROCEDURE: Vasectomy

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1) No strenuous activity for 2 weeks. No driving for 2-3 days and not while taking pain medication.
- 2) You may shower in 24 hours, but avoid bathing in a tub for 4 days Also, do not rub vigorously over the area where the incision is located.
- 3) Keep the incision clean and dry. Ice pack 20 min on, 40 min off for 24 hours
- 4) Continue to take your routine medication unless your doctor has advised you differently.
- 5) Do not take aspirin for 7 days after the surgery.
- 6) Take your pain medication as needed, but realize that this medication can cause constipation and it may be advisable to take a laxative. This medication can also effect your judgment and reflexes.
- 7) Change the dressing as needed.
- 8) You are not "safe" for sexual activity until your sperm has been examined by your urologist. Make sure you follow up with him/her in the office.
- 8) Call your urologist for an appointment. He/She will want to see you in about 2 weeks.

CALL YOUR DOCTOR:

If part of your incision opens up, bleeds, or becomes more painful.

If you notice increasing redness around the incision.

If you develop fever or chills.
