PROCEDURE:
Prosthetic Implant

DISCHARGE INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1) No strenuous activity.
ie. = no exercise, heavy lifting, shoveling, or sports, no sex or swimming.
- 2) Take your antibiotics as prescribed.
- 3) Continue to take your routine medications, unless your doctor has advised you differently.
- 4) Take your pain medication as needed, but realize that this medication can cause constipation. You may want to take a stool softener or a laxative. This medication can also affect your reflexes.
- 5) Do not take aspirin or aspirin type products for 1 week.
- 6) You may shower, but do not sit in the tub for extended periods. Also, do not rub vigorously over the incision.
- 7) Pull the pump down in your scrotum three times a day. It is between the testicles. This is important so that you can access it for activation later.
- 8) Do not attempt to activate the device until instructed to do so by your urologist.
- 9) Make sure you have a follow-up appointment with your urologist. He/She will want to see you in about 1 week.

CALL YOUR DOCTOR:

If you develop bleeding from the incision, increased redness around the incision, or if the incision opens up or becomes more painful.
If you develop fever or chills.
